







This autumn's exhibition highlights the work of artist Alain Bornain, recently exhibited at BPS22, whose artistic practice questions the subtle dimensions of human experience.

His work resonates with that of emblematic figures in contemporary art such as Joseph Beuys, Marcel Broodthaers and Tony Cragg,... creating a dialogue between artistic generations and approaches.

The exhibition explores universal and introspective themes such as memory, the passage of time and the ephemeral traces of human existence.

Throughout the exhibition, visitors are invited to reflect on these intangible concepts and observe how each artist approaches the fragility and transience of life.



AT THE 1985 PARIS F.I.A.C. THE ARTIST EXHIBITED ONE OF HIS LAST WORKS: « Ombelico di Venere »

- « COTYLEDON OMBELICUS VENERIS BOLOGNANO 1985 » IS THE COMPLETE WORDING WRITTEN BY BEUYS ON EACH OF THE DIFFERENT, UNIQUE WORKS ELABORATED AT BOLOGNANO.
- DURING THE SPRING OF 1985 BELLYS FOUND SOME PLANTS OF MEDITERRANEAN ORIGIN AMONG THE ROCKS OF THE DURINI CASTLE. THESE PLANTS ARE COMMONLY CALLED NAVEL OF VENUS DUE TO THEIR PARTICULAR FORM.

BEUYS GATHERED A CERTAIN QUANTITY AND THEN PLACED THEM ON ABSORBENT PAPER OF DIFFERENT SIZES AND SEEING TO THEIR DESICCATION BY MEANS OF A RUDIMENTARY PRESS CONSTRUCTED NI A CRAFT FASHION BY USING VARIOUS LAYERS OF WOOD HELD TOGETHER WITH COMMON CARPENTERS CLAMPS.

DURING SEPTEMBER THE ARTIST ELABORATED THE WHOLE WORK, CAREFULLY CHOOSING FOURTEEN PLANTS DESICCATED ON THE ABSORBENT PAPER HAVING AMAZINGLY WATER-COLOURED TONES. THESE PLANTS WERE THEN ATTENTIVELY PLACED BETWEEN TRANSPARENT GLASS.

THE ARTIST STUDIED A SPECIAL WHITE FRAME ALMOST BY WAY OF ONCE AGAIN ELABORATING THE PHYSICAL DRYING TIME, THE FILTER OF THE MAGICAL INTERVENTION, IN THIS WAY RECOMPOSING A NATURAL HISTORY OF BIOPHYSICS

AND TOTAL THOUGHT.

THE FOURTEEN WORKS RINGED NI THE WHOLE PARISIAN STAND WHILE THE PRESS WAS PLACED ON THE FLOOR IN THE CENTRAL AREA. HIGH UP ON THE RIGHT WALL THERE WAS A BANNER MEASURING FOUR METRES BY ONE BEARING THE WRITING « OMBELICO DI VENERE » AND SIGNED BY JOSEPH BEUYS.

THIS WAS THE LAST INSTALLATION BY THE ARTIST AT THE GRAND PALAIS IN PARIS.






Alain BORNAIN Image 22/A/18, 2022 Oil on canvas 40 x 50 cm








